

## Questions for reflection: Both sides of the coin

For the silent discussion comprised in the method “Both sides of the coin”, participants can record their thoughts and questions on flip charts and comment on the contributions of others as they explore the “exhibition”. In addition, the following – and/or other – questions for reflection can be written on the flip charts:

- › What does quality of life mean to you? What do you consider to be the elements of a good, happy life?
- › For an alternative to GDP, which aspects would have to be measured in order to determine a country’s quality of life?
- › How might you declutter your life while at the same time increasing your quality of life?
- › How could unemployment be reduced in Germany (or other country as appropriate)?
- › How can poverty be reduced in Germany (or other country as appropriate)?
- › Do we need yet more economic growth in Germany (or other country as appropriate)? Why?
- › How do you imagine a society without growth (life, work, consumption...)?

The questions can be added to or changed as desired.
